St. George Cathedral Stewardship Council Meeting Minutes- September 22, 2021

- Members present included: Fr. Ovi, Emil Alecusan, Debbie Maier and Terry Seeberger. The meeting was conducted virtually.
- Emil called the meeting to order at 6:40 pm.
- Fr. Ovi began the meeting with a prayer.
- Minutes of the August 11, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Debbie motioned to approve and Terry seconded. Motion approved.
- August 2021 financial results showed a Net Ordinary Income of \$21,040. The Festival contributed net income of \$14,226. An additional donation was \$7,500. Expenses were in line with budget. The investment account had an unrealized gain of \$6,437 due to the financial markets. This brought the total Net Income to a gain of \$27,477 for the month.

Net Ordinary Income for the first two months of the fiscal year is \$22,180 and Net Income after market gains was \$32,064.

- At August 31, 2021 current assets totaled \$258,598 offset by current liabilities of \$15,064 for a net cash position of \$243,534.

Terry motioned to approve the financial report and Debbie seconded. Motion approved.

- The 2021-2022 budget was submitted by Fr. Ovi. It reflects assumptions to generate Net Income of \$17,330. There is no recognition for unrealized gains or losses from our investment portfolio. Terry motioned and Debbie seconded. Motion approved.

Debbie introduced the topic of applying for employer tax credits as a part of a federal program. Fr. Ovi said that he would pursue.

- The meeting concluded at 7:35. The next Stewardship Meeting is scheduled for October 20, 2021 at 6:30. It will be virtual.
