St. George Cathedral Stewardship Council Meeting Minutes- November 10, 2021

- Members present included: Fr. Ovi, Emil Alecusan, Debbie Maier and Harry Walsh. The meeting was conducted virtually.
- Emil called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.
- Fr. Ovi began the meeting with a prayer.
- Minutes of the October 20, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Fr. Ovi motioned to approve and Emil seconded. Motion approved.
- October 2021 financial results showed a Loss of (\$496). A grant from a financial institution which was initiated by a parishioner contributed \$2,000 and minimized our loss. Expenses were in line with budget. The investment account had an unrealized gain of \$6,929 due to the financial markets. This brought the total Net Income to \$6,439 for the month.

Net Ordinary Income for the first four months of the fiscal year is \$15,655 and Net Income after market gains is \$33,593.

- At October 31, 2021 current assets totaled \$257,921 offset by current liabilities of \$12,858 for a net cash position of \$245,063.

Debbie motioned to approve the financial report and Harry seconded. Motion approved.

- Fr. Ovi reported that the Employer Tax Credit Application was in progress.
- In other business the Stewardship Committee reflected on the outstanding job performance that Fr. Ovi has contributed to our church. In just the past two years Fr. Ovi navigated our parish through the challenges of the pandemic, shifted our major fundraisers to on-line ordering and curbside service, applied for thousands of dollars in federal grants, and positioned our investment portfolio to achieve significant returns. It also recognized the tireless efforts that Gabi has contributed to the success of our church. The Stewardship Committee unanimously recommended that performance bonuses be awarded to Fr. Ovi and Gabi. Debbie motioned and Harry seconded. Motion passed.
- The meeting concluded at 7:25. The next Stewardship Meeting is scheduled for December 15, 2021 at 6:30. It will be virtual.
