

St. George Cathedral Stewardship Council Meeting Minutes- March 16, 2021

- Members present included: Fr. Ovi and Emil Alecusan. Tony Orlando also participated.
- Emil called the meeting to order at 6:45 pm.
- Fr. Ovi began the meeting with a prayer.
- Minutes of February 10, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Fr. Ovi motioned to approve and Emil seconded. Motion approved.
- February 2021 financial results showed a Net Ordinary Income of \$4,861. Two curbside Fish Fry's contributed \$5,433 of profit. The Federal Government's Paycheck Protection Program provided funds of \$3,400 to reimburse expenses. The Investment account had an unrealized gain of \$759 due to the financial markets. This brought the total Net Income to \$5,620.

Fiscal Year-to-date shows Ordinary Income of \$25,391 and unrealized gains of \$21,265 for a total Income of \$46,656.

At February 28, 2021 current assets totaled \$202,862 offset by current liabilities of \$13,052 for a net cash position of \$189,810.

Emil motioned to approve the financial report and Tony seconded. Motion approved.

- In other business Fr. Ovi mentioned that there will be a sarmale fundraiser on April 3 and a St. George curbside dinner on April 25. Also, Fr. Ovi said that very generous donations will cover much of the cost of the new sound system being installed in the next few weeks.
- The meeting concluded at 7:25. The next Stewardship Meeting is scheduled for April 14, 2021 at 6:30.
