Pentecost is where the Incarnation is headed, the movement is always toward the descent of the Holy Spirit - after Christ redeems our fallen nature on the Cross, the Holy Spirit is sent to guide us into all truth.


God wants to live in us, to join us to Himself. This was the Divine Will from the moment of creation, finally realized on the day of Pentecost.
