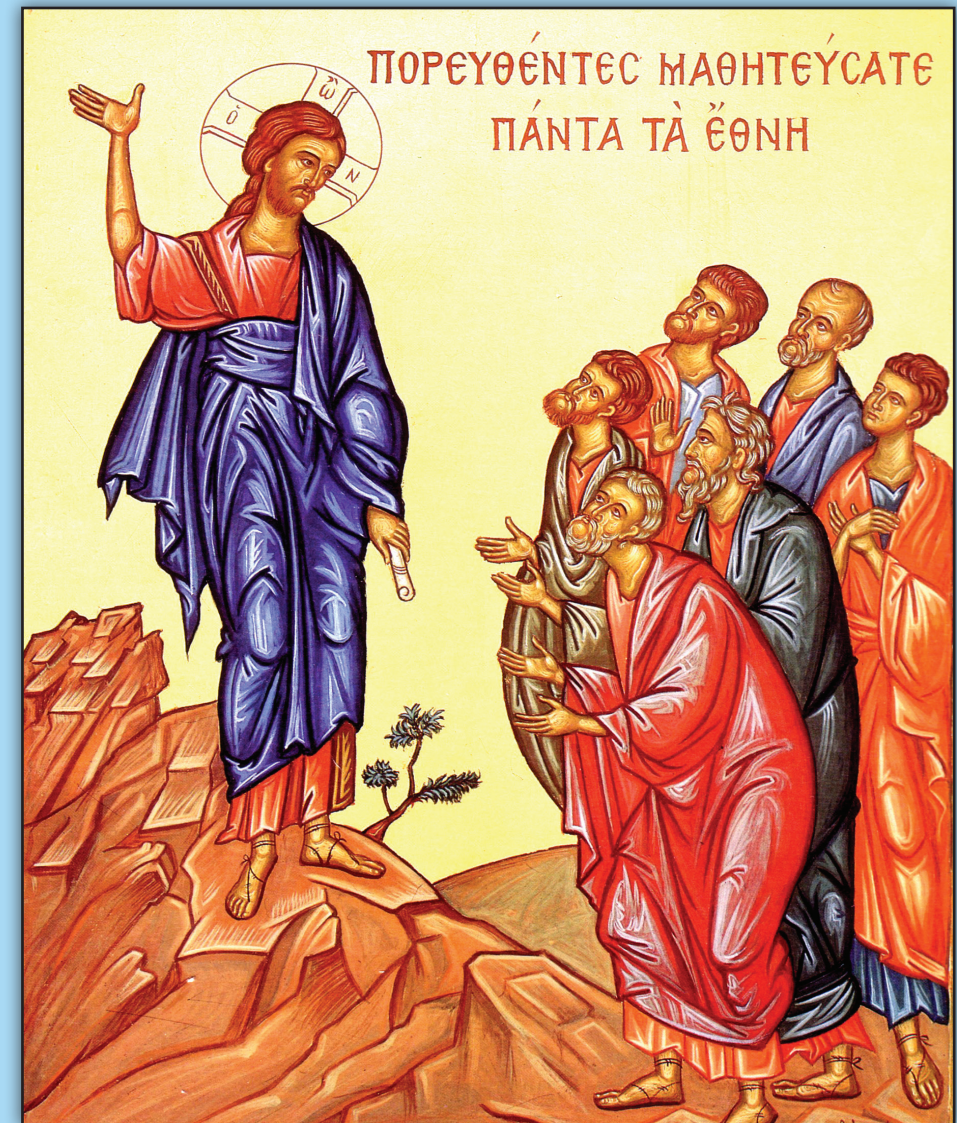


## THIRD SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

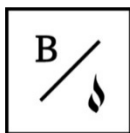
