# FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

## Asking Jesus to Leave


Of all the miracle stories of Jesus, the one recorded in today's Gospel reading stands out as unique. In most other occasions when Jesus healed or cured, the result was that more people came and asked to be cured. However, in the case of Jesus expelling demons from the man in the Gadarene territory, the result was that the whole village came out and asked Jesus to leave that area! (Matthew 8:34)

Ingratitude is certainly not the reaction we would expect the townsfolk to have since a member of their community restored to his right mind by the command of Jesus. Previously, he was prone to fits of madness and the source of his madness was understood to be demonic possession. Jesus commanded the demons to leave the man and restored the man to his right mind. Had this been the end

of the story, perhaps the people would have been filled with gratitude. However, Jesus sent the demons into a herd of swine, which then jumped over a cliff and drowned.

Why did Jesus send the demons into the swine? According to Jewish law, pork is considered to be an unclean product. Jews were to have no contact with pork. Because of this, the Jews of that town were breaking their own religious law.

By expelling the demons into the swine, Jesus not only healed a man, but also reestablished a forgotten value system in a town. Unfortunately, the inhabitants were not ready to receive this lesson. It is no surprise, then, why they met Jesus with such ingratitude and asked Him to leave their district.

# St. George Cathedral Stewardship Council Meeting Minutes- May 19, 2021

- Members present included: Fr. Ovi, Emil Alecusan, Debbie Maier. Jacqui Oprean and Tony Orlando also attended.
- Emil called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.
- Fr. Ovi began the meeting with a prayer.
- Minutes of April 14, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Debbie motioned to approve. Motion was seconded by Fr. Ovi. Motion approved.
- April 2021 financial results showed a Net Ordinary Income of \$5,852. The St. George Curbside Patron Saint Dinner contributed \$2,893 of profit. Routine expenses were in line with the budget. Major expenses were incurred for tree removal (\$1,800) and reimbursing the Diocese for the Paycheck Protection Program (\$3,500). The investment account had a realized gain of \$9,608 due to the financial markets. This brought the total Net Income to \$10,160.

Fiscal Year-to-date shows Ordinary Income of \$40,844, unrealized gains of \$29,907, major expenses of (\$5,300) for a total Income of \$65,451.

- At April 30, 2021 current assets totaled \$221,898 offset by current liabilities of \$14,193 for a net cash position of \$207,705.
  - Debbie motioned to approve the financial report and Emil seconded. Motion approved.
- Jacqui Oprean gave a review of the investment account. Fr. Ovi proposed moving \$10,000 from the cash account to the Edward Jones investment account. Jacqui made recommendations on allocating funds within the account. After discussion Debbie motioned to approve the suggestions and Emil seconded. Motion approved.
- Emil presented a report on the profile of parish weekly offerings. He noted that 19% of parishioners contribute to 53% of weekly offerings. From another perspective 62% of parishioners give 25% of weekly offerings. As has been stated before weekly offerings are not large enough to sustain the church financially. Consequently, we have to resort to fundraising events such as Fish Fry's and the Festival.

■ The meeting concluded at 8:00. The next Stewardship Meeting is scheduled for June 16, 2021 at 6:30.
